Installation

How to install the Template

In order to proceed with the theme installation, you need to make sure you have the latest version of WordPress on your self-hosted site.

To install this theme you must have a working version of WordPress already installed. For information on installing the WordPress platform, please see the WordPress Codex. Upon downloading the .zip file from Themeforest, you'll have all files you need inside. Extract the .zip file and inside you will find the theme zip file called "coffeebean.zip", that is the file you need to install.

Follow the steps below to install theme:

1. Navigate to **Appearance > Themes**.
2. Click **Add New** then **Upload Theme**.
3. Click **Choose File** and Navigate to find the **coffeebean.zip** file on your computer and click **Install Now** button. The theme will be uploaded and installed.
4. Activate the newly installed theme. Go to **Appearance > Themes** and **Activate** the installed theme.

1. Project Type — **Standard** for showing featured image as Page Title background, **Gallery** - shows portfolio images in Slider which defined in Gallery Options below, **Video** shows Selfhosted or remote Youtube/Vimeo video which set in options below.

2. Portfolio item size — define size of block with portfolio image in Portfolio page, default is 1x1, also available 1x2, 2x1, 2x2, 3x1, 3x3.

3. Portfolio style — set up Header image and Title style and visual effect when opening Portfolio item and scrolling down: **Fade Effect** with different Page Title position, **No Effect** with Title position.

4. Title position — shows Page Title Over Header image or Under Header after scroll.

5. Show Title before scroll — turn it off if you want hide Page Title over image before page scroll.

6. Subtitle — short text under Page Title.

7. Intro text — short text before main content with special grey block with different aligning as set below.

8. Intro text position — position for Intro text: Right, Center or Left with 1 or 2 columns styling.

9. Replace image in Header — only for Standard portfolio style you can replace header image which defined in Featured Image field, replaced image will show in current Item Page but Featured only in Portfolio Page.

10. Recent Works filters to display — you can define what categories of Portfolio show in Recent Works area, smart algorytm show all if not defined.

11. Client — client name for Client field under main content in Portfolio item page.

12. Website title — project website title for field under main content in Portfolio item page.

13. Website URL — project website URL.

Logo font, Menu Font, Body font, H1-H6 Headers Font:

Sets of parameters for fonts, colors, style and weight.

Links & Main Color

Main and Links Color:

Main color and links on all pages of template.

Global Colors

Menu Links Color, Menu Background Color, Title Font Color, Title Background Color, Page Font Color, Page Background Color:

Global color settings for text and backgrounds. This colors can be overridden with Page color options.

Common settings

Page preloader:

Enable or disable loading animation for page.

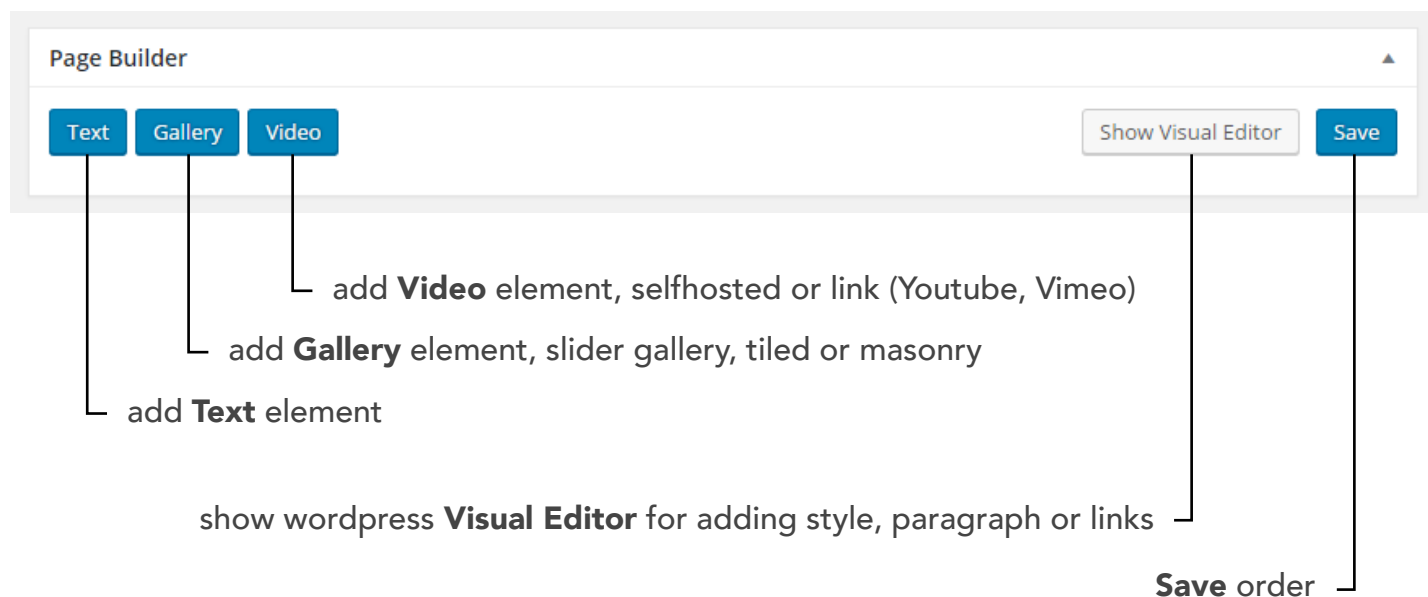

Page Builder by ThemeWorm

Plugin Overview

Simple Page builder is useful plugin for adding text, images, galleries and video to your Portfolio, Blog or Single page. It is not visual composer but easy way to build beautiful pages.



Please remember this algorithm to make your work with website more productivity:

1. Click add **Element** (Text, Video, Gallery).
2. Fill in fields and set parameters if you need.
3. Click **Save and Close**.



Save and Close button saves your current Page Builder information and you don't need click **Save** again.

Example with Text element:

1. First field - **Element Title** (used only for names in builder).
2. **Text** - HTML or plain text to show on your Page.
3. **Text columns count** - 1 or 2 columns for Text.
4. **Font size** - select your font size if you want to override default size.
5. **Line height** - choose line height for Text.
6. **Font and Background Color** - choose your color for Text and its background.
7. **Padding** - type padding in pixels for Text element.
